During his third season at Gonzaga, the team reached the Elite Eight at the NCAA tournament and he was given the Julius Erving Award. Hachimura was the first Japanese basketball player to be selected in the first round of the NBA draft. In addition to playing for the Washington Wizards, Hachimura is a member of the Japanese National Basketball Team.
