

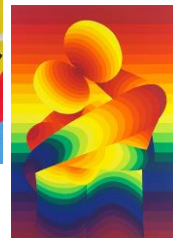
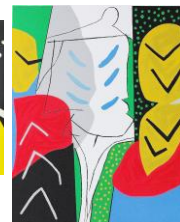
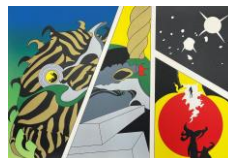
66th CWAJ PRINT SHOW

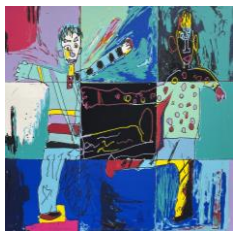

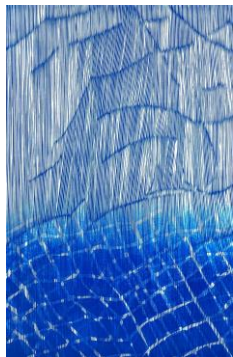
