The College Women's Association of Japan (CWAJ) will celebrate International Women's Day 2024 on March 8 with a program: *Visions for Change.* Dr. Mieko Nakabayashi, an esteemed expert commentator on politics and social issues, will give the keynote address. Three trailblazing Japanese women from diverse backgrounds will share their inspiring experiences and visions for change to achieve a more inclusive and just society. An interactive Q&A discussion, moderated by Dr. Emiko Magoshi, will follow. The evening will conclude with a networking reception.
