College Women's Association of Japan (CWAJ) has received an award from the Gender Equality Bureau of the Cabinet Office, "Women's Challenge Support Award". Ever since its founding in 1949, CWAJ has been supporting women through travel grants and scholarships, but this is the first time for CWAJ to receive a recognition from a central government agency.
